About BCNC

Birmingham City Netball Club is an established intermediate level netball club for girls in the South of Birmingham. We started in 1996 and now cater for school years 3 to 11. We are there to promote the love of netball and to develop the skills of members in playing and eventually umpiring and coaching. The Club is affiliated to England Netball (Club number 7055) and is ready to renew its Bronze CAPS Award.

Membership of BCNC

Welcome to Birmingham City Netball Club!

The people who run the Club do not make any money out of it. They give their time, effort and resources because they love netball. They want to share their enthusiasm for the sport with you.

You have the choice whether or not to belong to Birmingham City Netball Club. If you do decide to belong, you are expected to honour all your commitments unless unavoidably prevented.

Your responsibilities (players and parents)

- Keep the Club Rules and Code of Conduct.
- Parents must complete the Club registration form and sign the Code of Conduct for Parents.
- Pay all fees by BACS as soon as they are due.
- Purchase the minimum Club kit (dress, pants, hoodie, socks) from Club and wear kit to matches.
- Come prepared to play, wearing no jewellery. Make sure your nails are cut, long hair tied back (low ponytail), trainers laced and tied tightly.
- Players' mobile phones to be switched off during training and placed in the box provided by the Club.
- Attend training sessions punctually and wear Club's training tee shirt.
- Be available for matches and if selected attend 20 minutes before the start of play. Pay match fees at the match.
- If unavailable for matches let the Club know at least one week in

- advance (except for illness).
- Show respect for other players, Club Officials, umpires etc.
- Demonstrate sportsmanship on and off court.
- Make your own way to matches, sharing transport with fellow team members as necessary.
- Where Club transport to an event is provided, you are expected to use it, to ensure that it is cost-effective.
- Maintain personal fitness through activities outside the Club.
- The Club should normally have the first call on your leisure-time activities.

Our Responsibilities

- We will exercise the duty of care towards you and not discriminate against you unfairly. (See the section on Safeguarding.)
- We will provide good quality coaching by experienced coaches.
- We will acknowledge excellence, effort and progress.
- We will give all players opportunity to play in the local Intermediate League, adult leagues (from Year 8) and tournaments.
- We will enter talented players in the Regional League, and encourage them to go to Satellite and County training squads.
- We will encourage older players to develop umpiring, coaching and team management skills through our linked Bournville & Selly Oak Little League.

What it costs

- First of all, **commitment** from you and **support** from your family.
- Membership fees are payable monthly throughout the year:
 - £12.00 on the 10th of the month by Bank Standing Order, starting with the month after joining. (£9.00 for year 3 -5 who attend the Beginners' session)
- England Netball affiliation (runs from 1st September to 31st August): the Club pays this on your behalf **if** you have an unbroken 6 month record of standing order payments when affiliation becomes due.
- Match fees: generally £4 per match (£5 indoor leagues) and pro rata.
- Tournaments and other competitions costs of travel, umpiring fees etc. will be notified at the time.
- We will try to help you sort out any financial problems with membership.
